WW1 Research

Helen attended the Wayland WW1 commemoration launch in August. Helen to ask Mark Bunning if he can produce and 'laminiate' a copy of an old (1912?) Carbrooke Map, which we can add the names of the soldiers to, and where they lived.

Perhaps we can do the same to other historical maps , so we can display them.

Helen has also created a 'cloud' group for the group so we can share information. (Through Dropbox)

We could use electoral rolls to find people. Helen will find the maps, and Angela to find the addresses of the soldiers from 1911 census.

Helens talk 10th September 2pm on the Knights Hospitallers & Carbrooke Commanderie.

Chris Jenner bought his model interpretation of one of the buildings from the Commanderie, using the archaeological evidence uncovered during the dig at the school before the extension was built c1998 (written report) and his knowledge of the building and joinery trade. The model was amazing, precisely to scale and proved very informative when imagining how Mediaeval buildings could have looked. We offer our grateful thanks for creating such a fantastic model, although it will need a protective cover over it before it can be put on permanent display.

Suggestions of a medieval cookbook, and getting photos of artefacts found would make a good display.
